This is to inform you of **Proclamation No. 845** dated 15 November 2019, declaring the following regular holidays and special non-working days for the year 2020 to be observed throughout the country.

A. Regular Holidays

January 01	-	New Year's day
April 09	-	Araw ng Kagitingan / Maundy Thursday
April 10	-	Good Friday
May 01	-	Labor Day
June 12	-	Independence Day
August 31	-	National Heroes Day
November 30	-	Bonifacio Day
December 25	-	Christmas Day
December 30	-	Rizal Day

B. Special Non-Working Holidays

February 25	-	EDSA People Power Revolution Anniversary
August 21	-	Ninoy Aquino Day
November 02	-	Additional Special (non-working) Day
December 08	-	Feast of the Immaculate Conception of Mary
December 24	-	Additional Special (non-working) Day
December 31	-	Last Day of the Year

Still to be announced are the dates when the national holidays for the observance of Eidul Fitr and Eidul Adha shall fall.

SECTION 2. The proclamations declaring national holidays for the observance of Eidul Fitr and Eidul Adha shall hereafter be issued after the approximate dates of the Islamic holidays have been determined in accordance with the Islamic calendar (Hijra) or the lunar calendar, or upon Islamic astronomical calculations, whichever is possible or convenient. To this end, the National Commission on Muslim Filipinos (NCMF) shall inform the Office of the President of the actual dates on which these holidays shall respectively fall.

SECTION 3. The Department of Labor and Employment shall promulgate the implementing guidelines for this Proclamation.


SECTION 4. This Proclamation shall take effect immediately.

SECTION 5. This Proclamation shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.
